THE GOSPEL IN SIX TRUTHS



1. WE ARE ALL SINNERS

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

Sin is our rebellion against a holy God.

It affects our thoughts, our words, our actions, and our hearts.

— Romans 3:23 (KJV)



2. THE PENALTY FOR SIN IS DEATH

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

The Bible teaches that those who die apart from Christ will stand before God's righteous judgment, resulting in **conscious, eternal punishment in hell.**

— Romans 6:23 (KJV)



3. GOD LOVES US AND SENT JESUS

"But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

There was nothing we could ever do to earn God's forgiveness. His love led Him to the cross.

— Romans 5:8 (KJV)



4. JESUS PAID THE PRICE FOR OUR SINS

"For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him."

Jesus Christ, the perfect and sinless Son of God, took our place. God didn't ask us to provide the sacrifice—we never could have. He provided it Himself.

He bore the judgment we deserved on the cross.

— 2 Corinthians 5:21 (KJV)



5. JESUS ROSE FROM THE DEAD

"He is not here: for He is risen, as He said."

Three days after His death, Jesus rose bodily from the dead. His resurrection declared His victory over sin and death and confirmed that His work on the cross was complete.

— Matthew 28:6 (KJV)



6. WE MUST RESPOND IN FAITH

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

Salvation is received through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

Our confidence rests entirely in Jesus Christ—not in ourselves.

Repentance and faith are not good works that earn salvation—they are the God-ordained response to the finished work of Christ.

— Romans 10:9 (KJV)
